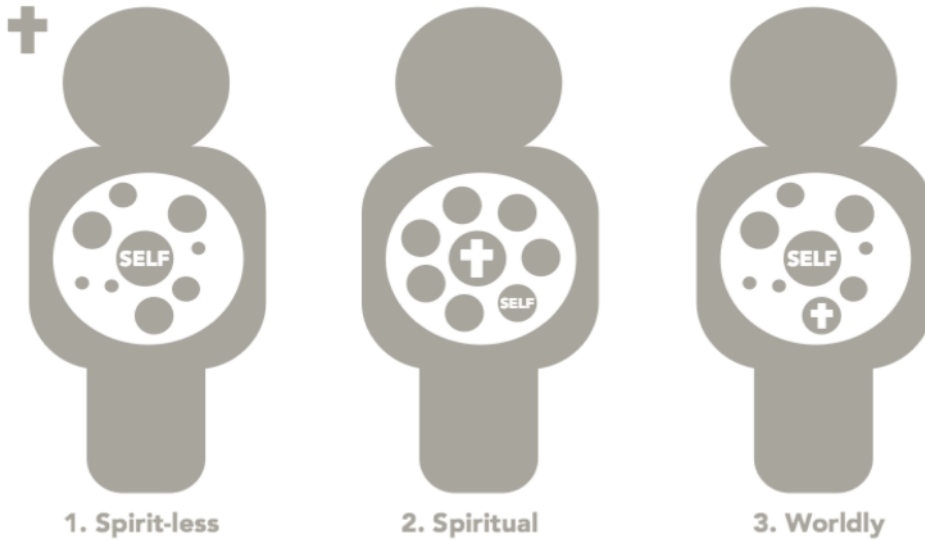
'Who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?'
